2015 Inas International Cricket Series - 2015 World Cup

Cricket Australia, in consultation with Cricket Victoria, Lord's Taverners Australia and AUSRAPID, has been successful with its bid for the 2015 Inas International Cricket Series to be held in Melbourne, Australia.

The opportunity to play this event alongside the 2015 World Cup was such a vital opportunity in the growth of cricket for people with an intellectual disability, that it was unanimously decided to alter the previous cycle and stage it in the last 10 days of March alongside the 2015 World Cup in Melbourne

This will be the first time that an International event of the magnitude of the 2015 World Cup will incorporate an International All Abilities event alongside. Australia leads the way.

Opening Ceremony

All athletes and officials involved in both the International Cricket Series and the All Abilities National Championships will be invited to attend the opening ceremony. It will be fantastic to have Australia's best blind, deaf and cricketers with an intellectual disability all in the same room at the same time along with the best cricketers with an intellectual disability from England. It will be a ground breaking celebration of embracing diversity and inclusion. Invitations will be issued to all World Cup 2015 participating countries to showcase the ability of the players in a bid to encourage those countries to expand their work in providing opportunities for people with a disability in their countries.
